Organ Concert – Celebrating the 50th Anniversary of the Centennial organ: Sunday, October 8 | 3:00 pm | Roseville Campus | Centennial UMC will celebrate the 50th anniversary of its 39-rank Schantz pipe organ, the first Schantz organ installed in Minnesota. The dedicatory recital was performed by Edward Berryman on October 8, 1967. This anniversary program will include organ works by J. S. Bach, Eugene Gigout, and Charles Callahan; a work for organ and brass by Giovanni Gabrieli, as well as congregational hymns. Centennial's organist, Bob Nienaber, will be the recitalist and the Chancel Choir and Centennial Brass will also perform. The concert is open to all, a free-will offering will be received, and a reception will follow.
