

### **Habitat for Humanity 2020 Project Update**

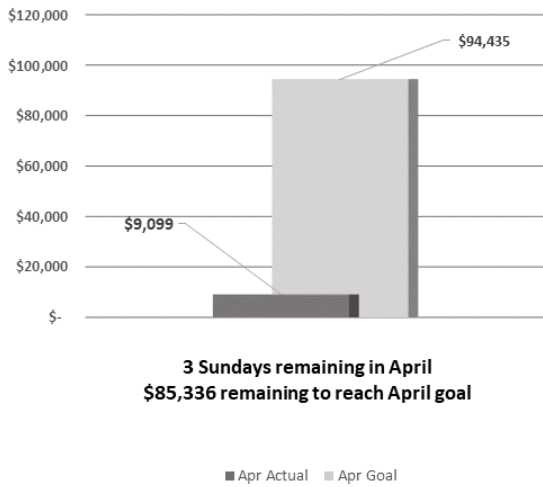
