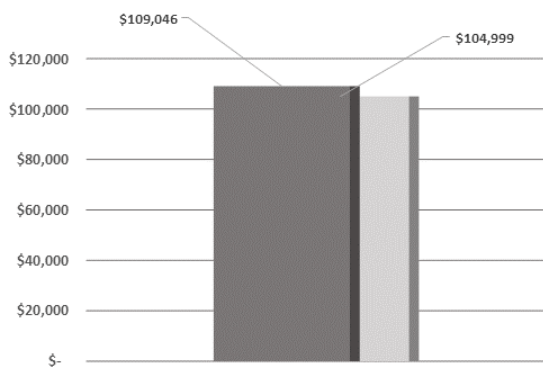

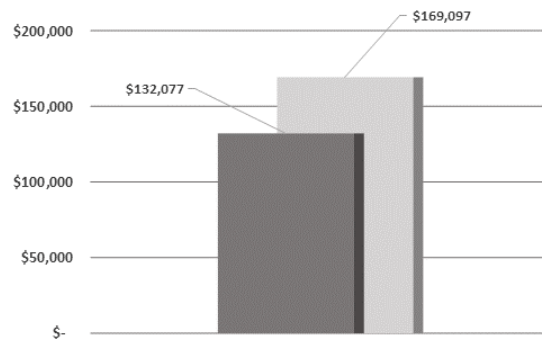
Centennial Mar 2020 Giving
