

Phase 2 Reopening

- A. **Activities allowed in Phase 1 Reopening are also allowed in Phase 2 Reopening.**
- B. **Small groups**
 1. **Small groups can meet if scheduled in advance.**
 - a. **In order to gain experience with the procedures, in the first three weeks after entering Phase 2 Reopening:**
 - i. **group size is limited to a maximum of 10 people per meeting;**
 - ii. **only two meetings are allowed per week.**
 - b. **In week 4 and beyond, group size maximum is 15 people per meeting and there is no limit on the number of meetings unless constrained by room availability or disinfection requirements.**
 - c. **Simultaneous meetings are allowed, subject to room availability and disinfection requirements.**
 - d. **Only one meeting is allowed in a specific location in a 24-hour period.**
 - e. **Staff have discretion in scheduling meetings to minimize exposure among people in separate meetings.**
 2. **Participants must follow all procedures in the Small Group Activities section of this Plan. These procedures include completing a health screening survey before entering the building, using hand sanitizer upon entry, wearing a mask that covers nose and mouth at all times, social distancing, and other procedures.**
 3. **The group leader is responsible for ensuring that all participants understand the procedures they must follow and that participants adhere to the procedures before, during and after the meeting.**
 4. **Participants are not free to move about anywhere in the church building. Movement is restricted to the entrance area, the path to the meeting room, and to the designated restrooms.**
 5. **Restrooms will be open subject to the protocols elsewhere in this Plan, including social distancing in any line and restroom use by one occupant at a time (unless an individual needs assistance).**
 6. **No food or drink is allowed, except participants can bring their own water if it is used very infrequently.**
 7. **The church offices will remain closed.**
- C. **Funerals are allowed, with limited capacity.**
 1. **Funeral services are allowed, subject to the usual constraints of staff and facility availability.**

2. There will be no visitation before, or reception following, the funeral service.
3. Arrival and exit procedures are specified in the General Procedures subsection of the Occupancy, Capacity, and Arrival section of this Plan. This includes a health screening survey, hand sanitation, wearing a mask at all times, moving immediately into the sanctuary upon entry, leaving the building immediately after being dismissed from the sanctuary, and others.
4. The number of participants is limited to 50% of the capacity calculated using social distancing requirements in each sanctuary.
5. There will be no singing by the participants, and any vocal or instrumental music will follow the procedures in the subsection on Vocal and Instrumental Music in the Indoor Worship and Ceremonies section of this Plan.

Phase 3 Reopening

All activities allowed in Phase 2 Reopening are allowed in Phase 3 Reopening.

Funeral services are allowed, subject to the provisions in Phase 2, except the number of participants is limited only by the capacity requirements for social distancing in the sanctuary.

Small group meetings can have no more than 25 people with no limit on the number of meetings per week, unless cleaning and disinfection needs require a limit.

Ministry and outside groups can meet, with a limit of perhaps 25 people at any meeting. All provisions in this Plan must be followed, including the health screening survey, wearing masks, frequent hand sanitation, social distancing, and others. The group's leader is responsible for training participants in the requirements in this Plan and ensuring that they are followed.
